Pastor's Column

Around the Parish...

St. Brendan's welcomed Deacon Andrew O'Leary from the Diocese of Spokane Washington at all our Masses last Sunday. What made the Family Mass, (9:30 AM), extra special was that Bishop Tom Daly, Bishop of Spokane WA., welcomed and introduced Deacon Andrew to his home parish as a boy, St. Brendan's Parish. Fr. Lourdu welcomed Deacon Andrew to his Mass and the entire faith community provided a welcome to our newest parishioner – at least for a year before Deacon Andrew O'Leary hopefully is ordained a priest on May 21, 2022.



I am prejudiced but I recall the open and welcoming disposition of St. Brendan's parish - church, and school, when I was newly ordained. I remember with a degree of pride and excitement the encouragement received from the good people of St. Brendan parish. I am confident that Deacon Andrew will also be on the receiving end of a wonderful journey at St. Brendan's.

The formal title to be used for Deacons is "Reverend Mister..." just as for priests the formal title is "Reverend...". Deacon O'Leary is a "transitional deacon" as opposed to a "permanent deacon". Permanent deacons are ordained for a life of service to the people of God as a deacon. If married, the wife must agree for a man to become a deacon.

This is opposed to "transitional deacons" who must. Go through the levels of the sacrament of Holy Orders. Those levels are first deacon; then priest and finally bishop (archbishop). All priests and bishops are always also deacons, just as all bishops are also priests. It is in the position of the bishop or (archbishop) that the fullness of the priesthood is truly realized and their mission is to "preach, teach and sanctify." Priests assist the bishop and deacons assist the priests and bishops and faith community. One of the primary roles of the deacon, permanent or transitional, is to proclaim the Word of God. This means that if there are bishops, priests and one deacon, the proclaimer of the Word of God is always the deacon. Deacons can also perform marriages where there is no Mass and Baptism sacramental ceremonies.

Please introduce yourself to Deacon Andrew O'Leary! He is anxious to get to know you all.




News from St. Brendan

Children's Faith Formation – Registration Open! Classes Begin September 19!


Welcome back returning and new families!

The St. Brendan Children's Faith Formation program welcomes all parish children in grades 1-8 who do not attend Catholic school. Our *Family Catechesis* program provides grade-level Faith Formation classes and sacramental preparation for Reconciliation, Communion and Confirmation.

Preparation for First Reconciliation and First Communion is a two-year program, usually beginning in 1st grade, with children receiving First Communion in the spring of their 2nd grade year. Children may also begin First Year preparation in 2nd grade, receiving First Communion in the spring of their 3rd grade year.

Confirmation preparation for students **not** attending Catholic school is a two-and-a-half-year program, beginning in 6th grade. Students attending another Catholic school (parochial or independent) may begin classes in 7th grade. Confirmation is administered in the fall of the 8th grade year.

Classes are held most Sundays from 10:45 – 11:45 a.m. Families are expected to attend the 9:30 a.m. Family Mass and then proceed to Faith Formation Class. For the full schedule and registration, please go to: <https://www.stbrendanparish.org/faith-formation.html>
