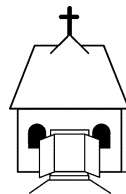

PASTOR'S COLUMN

Feeding the Multitude...

No one can deny that's what the message is in this gospel passage is that Jesus comes to feed us and to give us nourishment that will sustain us throughout our lives. The nourishment is the enduring spiritual gift that we are loved is open to all. I believe we need to understand and realize this deeper message from Jesus to us all from this weekend's readings. We are being given an insight as to how to accomplish the very purpose of all human existence, namely, to live as God would have us trusting in him and in looking upon our brothers and sisters as truly members of our human family. Through this gospel, we also see yet another dimension of Jesus compassion for the human condition.



We have an example of the enduring perseverance of God's love for us, (termed "scandalous love", because it never fails, in seminary teaching), that, even in the face of odds or circumstance that would to the human eye seem hopeless, allows us to never give up hope and believe in God's Providence. I believe this should always encourage the human heart. As we journey through life, and have improved understanding of this message, I believe we are transformed into caring persons who live lives of gratitude for what they can do and experience – simply by caring for each other.

What I also find appealing in this gospel passage is what we do not see. Jesus asked no qualifying questions before feeding the multitude. He doesn't ask them whether they are gentile or Jew he doesn't ask them if they are faithful or pagan; instead, he asks them if they wish to be fed. He then gently asks them to please recline and then proceeds to serve them from what he has. What a wonderful example for us to follow in our lives. May we always be alert in how we can help others.

I believe that we should follow this example of Christ in our lives and encourage all people to try to both communicate with God and partake of God's goodness in a way that allows authentic and improving relationship with God and others.

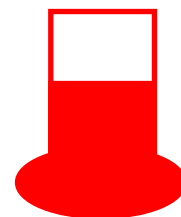

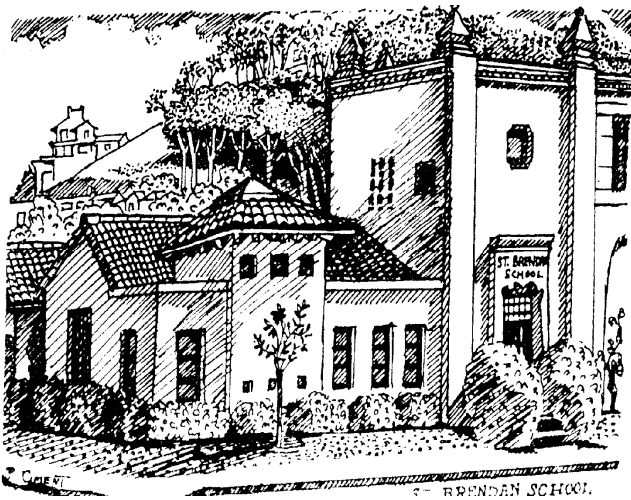
St. Brendan School Update:
