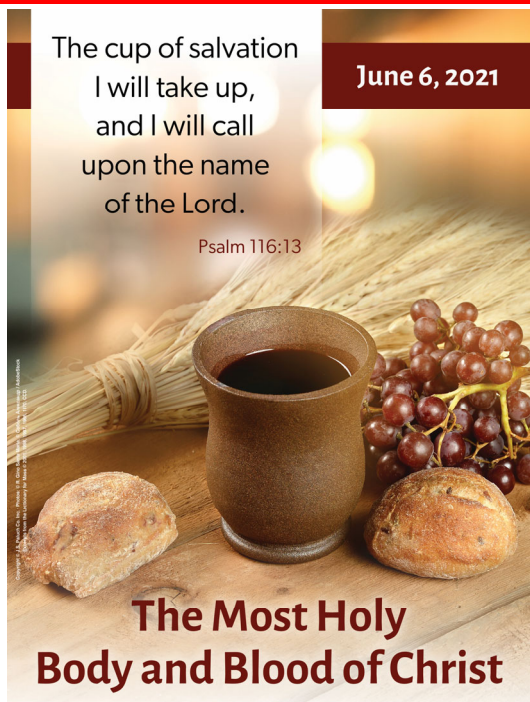

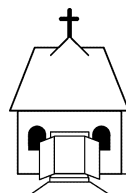

PASTOR'S COLUMN

Corpus Christi Sunday

Since Pope Urban IV initiated it in the year 1264, the Catholic Church has celebrated the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ with a solemn procession. This celebration takes place on the second Thursday after Pentecost. In many countries, including the United States, "Corpus Christi" takes place on the following Sunday. This feast is to celebrate and recognize the abiding presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist.



We have been celebrating the achievements of our graduates, families, and teachers throughout our country in these last few days and we will continue to do so – for human achievement should be celebrated and encouraged. At these events parents will gaze proudly on their children and sometimes their children's children and wonder at the magnificence of life as a gift from God. But human achievement pales in comparison to the gift of God in the sacrament of the Eucharist.

Below a story of a priest who understood well the value of this gift which we sometimes take for granted-
"In 2002, a man died who is revered as a hero in his homeland Romania. Alexandru Cardinal Todea had spent 31 years of his life in communist prisons, of which 15 years in solitary confinement. Once, after years, the priest was transferred to another prison. Tied up in the railway carriage, he saw his guards from the secret service "Securitate" unpack their bread and open a bottle of wine. Todea was hungry. But another longing burned in his eyes: "My God - I could not celebrate Holy Mass for so many years. And there is bread! And there's wine!" Finally he asked the guards: "Give me a crumb of bread and a sip of wine!" One of the guards took pity on him. He couldn't see the vibrations going on inside the priest. The invisible Eucharist in the rumbling railway carriage was the most intense of his life. Here he had received the strength to endure all the torture, humiliation and loneliness that would come upon him." – (YouCat.org)

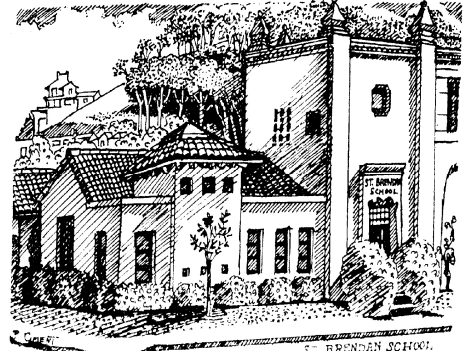
